## Directions to Theater Parking, Backstage, and Loading Dock

### TO THEATER PARKING

- From the 405 or 105 or 91 or 5 or 10 or 60...**take the 710 FWY South.**
- South of the 405 FWY **stay in the middle lane** (#2 lane)
- Follow the signs **to Downtown / Aquarium.** Do not go towards the Port / Queen Mary. **Do not exit at Sixth Street.**
- Stay to the left as the Freeway curves to the left starting just past the Broadway exit. **Do not exit at Broadway.**
- The 710 FWY will turn into **Shoreline Drive.**
- Turn left at the fourth light; **Pine Avenue.** The Hyatt hotel is on the corner.
- Go down two blocks and turn right at the 2nd light, **Seaside Way.**
- Go down two blocks and just before the pedestrian bridges **turn left** onto **Collins Drive.**
- The Theater Parking is at the top of the hill on Collins Drive on the right hand side.
- From your car walk to the southwest corner of the structure that opens to the pedestrian bridge that crosses Seaside Way. After crossing the pedestrian bridge, continue to walk under the covered area until it comes to a stop. To your left is the Artists Entrance. Enter there if the doors are unlocked. Otherwise go to your right and up the last set of stairs to the Terrace Theater/Center Theater loading dock.

### TO THE LOADING DOCK

- Go down two blocks and just before the pedestrian bridges **turn right** into the **North Dock** entrance. This is opposite **Collins Drive.**
- Go all the way up the hill of the loading dock.
- The Terrace Theater/Center Theater Loading Dock is on the left hand side. The dock is painted with safety yellow paint. The roll-up doors are painted white. The entry doors are green (Terrace Theater) and red (Center Theater).

- **The loading dock is for vehicles that are actively loading or unloading only. You're welcome to drive up to the dock to unload your vehicle. Once unloaded please park in the parking lot as described above. Thank you.**

## Directions to Theater Parking, Backstage, and Loading Dock

### TRUCK DRIVER'S ACCESS TO THE LOADING DOCK

- The metal section in the ground just off the dock is a truck leveler. It ramps down to minus 12" and up to dock height. Parking on the ramp can be tricky as the trailer's weight load can cause the ramp to slope side to side.
- It can be tough backing up to the dock as the ground slopes down steeply about 30' from the dock. Interstate tractors have the biggest problem. Good luck!
- We usually allow two trailers to park on the dock through the run of the show. Sometimes we can allow for some of the tractors to park in the loading ramp area. They cannot stay hooked to the trailers at the dock, as they will be blocking emergency access doors. Additional trailers will be parked in the Elephant Lot to the South side of the Arena, located just East of the Terrace Theater.
- Bus parking on the North Dock area must be arranged in advance with your **Event Manager**. Shore power is available.
